



# How to Download Library eBooks To Your Nook Simple Touch

## Step 1: Getting Started

The first time you download an eBook you will need to download **Adobe Digital Editions** and activate your free Adobe ID account.

- ◆ On your computer go to the Deerfield Public Library website at <http://www.deerfieldlibrary.org>
- ◆ From the **Read** tab click on **eBooks** and then click on the **My Media Mall** link.
- ◆ Click on the **"Help"** icon at the top of the page and then click on **Overdrive Help**.
- ◆ Click on the **"Getting Started"** link, scroll down and then click on the link for the **Nook**, then click on **"Getting Started with a Nook eReader"**.
- ◆ Click on the link for **Adobe Digital Editions** to download the free software.
- ◆ Follow the instructions to install the free **Adobe Digital Editions** software and get an **Adobe ID**.
- ◆ **Connect your Nook** to your computer. You will be asked to **sync** your Nook to your Adobe ID. You only have to do this the first time you set this up.

## Step 2: Selecting a Title

- ◆ Go to the DPL website at <http://www.deerfieldlibrary.org>
- ◆ From the **Read** tab click on **eBooks** and then click on the **My Media Mall** link.
- ◆ Click on the **Sign In** link on the upper right side of the page.
- ◆ Select **Deerfield Public Library** and then enter your Deerfield Public Library **card number**.
- ◆ In the black bar at the top of the page click on any of the links under **eBook Fiction**, **eBook Nonfiction**, or **Children & Teen**.
- ◆ Books that are **currently available** to be checked out will have a **darkened icon** in the upper right hand corner. If the icon is **shaded** the book is **checked out** and you can place a hold.
- ◆ You can also click on the **"Available Now"** link on the left side of the page to see books that are currently available to check out.
- ◆ If the book is available click on the blue **Borrow** box. Otherwise click on the blue **Hold** box.

## Step 3: Downloading & Transferring a Title

- ◆ Click on the blue **Download** box and choose the **EPUB** eBook format.
- ◆ Click on the **Confirm & Download** link.
- ◆ Your book should now automatically open in **Adobe Digital Editions**.
- ◆ **Connect your Nook** to your computer using the Nook's USB cable.
- ◆ Go to the **Library view** of Adobe Digital Editions by clicking on the **book shelf icon** on the top left.
- ◆ Locate the **Nook icon** on the left side of the page. **Click and drag** the title you wish to transfer over to the Nook icon. You should see a green + sign. **Transfer** the book.
- ◆ Your book will now be located in your Nook's **Library**.
